

Belarus electricity consumption



Overview

Belarus' electricity consumption amounted to 43. 2 billion KWh in 2024, up by 5 percent, the Minister said. The official said this was a record figure for Belarus. This allowed Belarus to develop electric transport, electricity supply to the population, and energy-intensive. What is Belarus' average energy consumption per person?

Most energy in Belarus is cheap fossil gas from Russia, [1] and Belarus is a net energy importer. In comparison, the world average is 142. 56 billion. Total electric power consumption = total net electricity generation + electricity imports - electricity exports - electricity transmission and distribution losses.
