

Stable shipments of solar inverters



Overview

Global PV inverter shipments grew by 10% to 589 gigawatts alternating current (GWac) in 2024. Asia Pacific, led by China, accounted for nearly all global growth, while the US and Europe declined. Huawei, Sungrow Power Supply, and Ginlong Solis are some of the largest inverter manufacturers worldwide. This is the first time the company has passed the 1GW threshold in a quarter since Q3 2023, and after reaching a five-year low of 850MW inverters shipped. 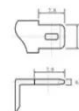
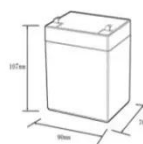

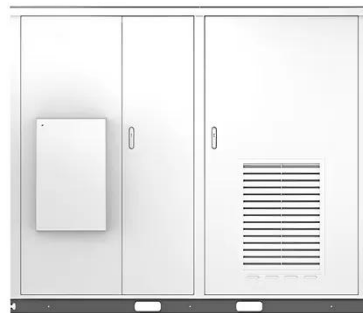
