Market competition analysis indicates that TANESCO accounts for 91% and 83% of the installed capacity and energy generation in the electricity generation market share respectively.

Unlike other energy commodities such as coal, oil and natural gas, electricity trade between countries is relatively limited as it is more technically complex and requires a direct cross-border interconnection.

Since 2019, the average electricity price in Tanzania has fluctuated between ~\$76/MWh in 2024 and
