Who are the top 20 global photovoltaic module manufacturers?

In 2024, the global solar module market continued to see the strongest players thrive, with the top four enterprises -- JinkoSolar, LONGi, Trina Solar and JA Solar -- collectively shipping over 320GW and dominating the industry.

Who is the largest solar panel manufacturer in the world?

JinkoSolar is the largest solar panel manufacturer in the world. The Shanghai-based company shipped 47.2GWp of solar panels in 2024's first six months, more than any other firm. JinkoSolar has 14 factories in China, Malaysia, Vietnam, and the US, and 57,000 employees, with 1,500 working in the firm's eight research and development centres.

Who is the best solar panel manufacturer?
